

Vietnam expects IFC assistance for priority projects

VNBusinessNews.com - Viet Nam expects to receive more assistance from the International Finance Corporation (IFC) for projects the country has prioritised, particularly in energy, transport and essential infrastructure facilities.

So Deputy Prime Minister Hoang Trung Hai told Laurence Carter, the Director of the Infrastructure Advisory Department of the IFC, a member of the World Bank, on April 21.

Deputy PM Hai asserted that the government is committed to reforming the economy, alleviating poverty, and fighting corruption and wants to receive further assistance from the WB.

For his part, Mr Carter said he would like to expand the IFC's consultancy programme for developing Vietnam's infrastructure. (VNA)
